



## WISCONSIN BIATHLON CUP RACE #3

### Sunday, January 28, 2018

Wisconsin Biathlon Cup Race #3 will take place at the Brown County Rifle Range and Reforestation Camp in Green Bay, Wisconsin

#### INTRODUCTION:

This event is an Open Interval Start event and a second, Novice Sprint race for Nordic skiers with no previous biathlon experience.

#### VENUE, REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES:

Event registration is online and very simple. There is a monetary penalty for same day registration so **PLEASE PRE-REGISTER ONLINE** at the appropriate link below (Open Race or Novice Race) at least two days prior to the race. **No fees are collected during online registration so there is no penalty for registering online and being a no-show. See fee schedule below and online.**

**Note registration will close at Noon on the day prior to the race.** Payment and bib assignment will take place between 9:00 – 9:30 AM at the biathlon range.

For the bib assignment, please bring:

1. Online registration printout (email to yourself by scrolling down after “Submitting” your online registration)
2. Exact cash or check payment (to “Bay Nordic Ski Club”, see fee schedule below)
3. USBA Red Book (received at your USBA safety training class) (Open Racers Only)
4. USBA Membership Card (if you are a Competitor member of USBA), OR **Filled out** USBA “member for a day” form (online at USBA web site below) (all Novice Racers)

Please bring adequate warm-up clothes and boots, as heated shelter is limited at the range. There is no running water so bring your own water supply. There is a Port-A-John located in the parking lot however.

### **OPEN RACE:**

- Certified biathletes, interval start, 10KM (PPSS), 5 skiing stages (2KM loops)
- 150M penalty loop for each missed shot
- Biathletes ages 10-16, interval start, 8KM (PPSS) , 5 skiing stages (1.6KM loops)

### **NOVICE RACE:**

The Novice race is designed for ages 10 and up providing an authentic biathlon experience.

- Interval start, 4.8KM (PP), 3 skiing stages (1.6 KM loops)
- 150-meter penalty loop is included for each missed shot. Volunteer coaches, basic shooting training, rifles, ammunition, timing and scoring will be provided. Our goal is to provide safe and easy access for all participants to have an authentic experience with the Winter Olympic sport of Biathlon.

### **FEE SCHEDULE:**

\$15 - Novice (non-Red Book Certified)

\$15 - Juniors (10 years minimum to participate, 15 years minimum to carry a rifle)

\$ 25 - WI Biathlon paid members and Blackhawk Ski Club members (or members of any Biathlon club)

ADDITIONAL \$10 if you choose not to register on this site and register in person on race day

10 if you do not have an annual USBA Competitor membership (this is the USBA "Member For a Day" rate and goes directly to the USBA)

ADDITIONAL \$5 trail fee for Brown Co (waived if you have an annual pass)

ADDITIONAL \$7 range fee for Brown Co Parks Department

A "Competitor" level annual USBA membership or USBA "member for a day" is required to cover race liability insurance.
